Tournament Info

FIDE rated open tournament in two groups.

Patron: Gergő Nagy, head of the district education committee.

<u>Objective</u>: to pay tribute to the Chess Olympiad in Budapest, to encourage people to engage with chess, especially young people of Budapest and to organize a small exhibition in connection with the Olympiad.

<u>Organizer</u>: Downtown Municipality Mayor's Office and 'Sirály Életmód' Sport Club with the support of Hungarian Chess Federation.

Form: Standard Swiss-tournament with 6 rounds in both groups.

<u>Time Control</u>: 2x90 minutes + 30 second increment per move, recording of moves is mandatory. Waiting time is 60 minutes.

Mobile phones and electronic devices

According to the FIDE rules such devices are not allowed to be used during the game. Those devices must be completely switched off and held in a bag or a box dedicated for this purpose on arbiter's desk.

Prizes

Prizes are guaranteed for at least 45 players (A: 30 / B: 15 players).

Category prizes are delivered only in case at least 3 players registered in that group.

One player can win only one prize.

Tax to be paid after monetary prizes.
