International FIDE tournament for U2400 and U1800 Chess Players

From 13 to 15 June 2025.

Objectives: Gain FIDE Ratings, build and further develop chess relations, provide opportunity for young players to participate in an international tournament and increase chess recognition.

Organizer: Paty Chess Club

Location: Hungary, Páty, Művelődési Ház (Community Center), Páty, Kossuth u. 77.

How to reach: 25 km from Budapest.
Buses leave from Budapest, Szell Kalman square, every 30 min.

When: 13-15 June 2025

Mode: FIDE standard regulation, Swiss system
6 rounds in 2 groups, pairing with Swiss Manager (FIDE rules)

70 minutes for the game with 30 seconds increment from move 1.

Other information: The tournament registrations, results, pairings: www.chess-results.com. Personal registration is mandatory for everyone before 16:30, Friday. Those who fail to register (even if they have a preliminary registration) will be deleted from the starting list and will not be paired.

Appeal: possible within 10 minutes after finishing the current round in writing at Chief Arbiter with a fee of HUF 10.000 (the fee is returned in case of success). The members of the appeal committee will be disclosed during the opening ceremony.
