Participants of the competition: Players, who born on or after 1.1.2007. and has no FIDE Ratings. Playing licence is not necessary.

Group „A”: players born on or after 1.1.2017.

Group „B”: players born between 1.1.2015 and 12.31.2016.

Group „C”: players born on or before 12.31.2014.

Format & System: 7 rounds, Swiss system (FIDE Dutch System), Swiss Manager program, according to FIDE Rapid and Blitz Rating Regulations (<https://handbook.fide.com/chapter/B02RBRegulations2024>)

Time control: 2 x 15 minutes

Tie-break system:

1. Earned score
2. Buchholz
3. Direct Encounter
4. Progressive

Sport regulations:

During the rounds accompanying persons (such as parents, coaches, teachers) are allowed in the playing hall only with the special permission of the arbiter.

An appeal can be submitted in writing to the Chief Arbiter, not later than the start of the next round. The appeal must be accompanied by a deposit fee of 10,000 HUF. If the appeal is accepted, the fee must be returned. The Appeals Committee will be announced before the first round.

In disputes, the applicable rules in force shall prevail.
